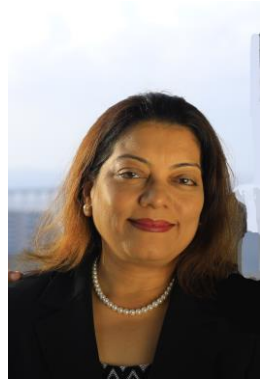

In 2000, I underwent fellowship in Advance pain management at Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital Pain Management Centre, Perth, Australia. Dr. Roger Goucke supervised the fellowship. At this centre I was entrusted to perform around 150 major interventional pain procedures independently and assisted in more than 300 pain procedures. This included the entire spectrum of managing chronic pain problems in form of various nerve blocks, facet rhizotomies, epidural injections, pumps, spinal cord stimulation, etc.

I am currently conducting a Pain clinic at Jaslok Hospital & Research Center on Wednesday/Friday (1.00 to 3.00 p.m.) since 2001, which caters to patients suffering from **chronic pain** either due to cancer or due to non-cancer conditions such as low back pain, post herpetic neuralgias, pain due to peripheral vascular diseases and so on. I have performed a wide variety of procedures including advanced pain therapies to cater to various chronic pain problems. These procedures are performed under fluoroscopic guidance as per IASP, ISIS, and ASIPP recommendations. I have also performed fair number of advanced implantable procedures and offer a comprehensive spectrum of all interventional techniques. I have till date performed about more than 10000 interventional pain procedures including advanced therapies with satisfactory results.

We are an accredited fellowship centre for a one year structured fellowship in Pain Medicine under Indian Academy of Pain Medicine since its inception under ISSP.
